




Fulfilling Our Promises

We are continuing to hammer away at improvements. Here's a brief summary:

- Distribution: We have increased our distribution team to four people, who now have the backlog of product totally sorted. Their immediate focus is to ensure that the correct product is at each branch.
- Purchasing: As of April, we have increased our core product purchasing people to two. Again, we look forward to the additional resources helping to streamline processes and ensuring the product you need is in our warehouses.
- Stock Holdings: The Melbourne branch has already proven a great addition to the team and Victoria's transporters really have their act together when it comes to getting stuff to your premises. The product, that used to take four or five days from Queensland, is for the majority of orders, on site in one! The fact that Victoria holds additional stock has boosted our efficiency across the country.



Stackers and Current Results

The Stackers are now fully operational at Caboolture, Perth & Melbourne. Although Perth is still in the final stages of being filled, we have seen extraordinary results in the following areas:

- 1. **Turn-around time:** Order turn around has improved tremendously, especially with large orders. Where as these orders once took two or three days to data input, pick, pack and send, they are now taking an efficient one or at most two, to get out the door.
- 2. **Reduced errors:** Picking errors have reduced even more than first expected. Last month, Caboolture's error count alone, was just two. (Or at least that's two that we knew of and actioned!) An impressive result, in such a short operational time. If you have had errors and haven't told us about it, please let us know so we can fix them.
- **3. Operational efficiency:** Stock count is an easier process once product is inside the Stacker, which allows for more accurate holdings, forecasting and ordering.

That's all well and good, but to be honest, the first stacker in Caboolture is just not *cutting the mustard!* The average Stacker carries out 15,000 movements per year. Taipan however, have clocked up 22,000 movements in our first 5 months- the highest case

of movements in this style of machine. What this means is services are due far more often than first expected and that means down time.

So, what have we done about it? Well, we decided that if one is not enough we had better get two! Our second Stacker for Queensland is due to arrive at the end of May, which we are hoping will further increase efficiencies to all customers across Australia.

Making recruitment a success

How many times have you hired a friend or friend of a friend's sisters' brother or similar? Successful recruitment is a constant challenge, here are Taipan's top 5 questions to consider at your next interview.....

1. Tell me about yourself, who you are and your story.

This question allows the candidate to feel comfortable and relax. Talking about themselves is usually an easy conversation starter and allows them to talk about outside passions. It gives employers time to 'get to know' the candidate in such a short period of time and allows employers to measure whether the candidates personal values align with the company values and ultimately, if they will fit with the company culture.


2. What aspects of the role appeal to you?

This question is important to gauge the interest level of the candidate of particular areas or aspects relating to the role. It also indicates their strengths and weaknesses by allowing them to express what interest level they have, these are usually self-identified strengths.

3. What are your long term career plans?

Use this questions to allow candidates to expose their wildest dreams, or let you know they might be chasing career progression. It's a good chance for employers to boast about their openness to career progression or that it's ok if that's not what the candidate is looking for. Employers can also gauge whether a candidate will be a long termer, or using this role as a stepping stone.





4. What type of person do you find the most challenging to work with?

If they say 'my boss' then their values probably don't align with yours, but keep in mind that their 'boss' may really be a challenge to work with! Finding out what makes their 'blood boil' in the workplace will indicate what type of person they are, who they respond to and whether or not they will upset the current culture. Maybe they find it a challenge to work with lazy people, or people with low motivation, which in turn will likely be a positive thing for the company.



5. What do customers mean to you?

This question will indicate whether or not the candidate feels that customers are important. At Taipan, our Mission; To create a base of raving fans by delivering outstanding customer experiences, starts with our staff and the importance they put on customer service. Customers are what keeps our cogs turning and we want our future employees to value their importance.



With a little preparation you can maximise your chances of hiring someone that will remain with your company longer term. This will not only save you a huge amount of money but will help to generate stability and credibility in the market.
