JIC Male Hose tails and what they are good for



We understand you have more knowledge about what happens in the field than we do and sometimes you have to use alternative measures to get a desperate customer going.

Just letting you know that our JIC male hose tails are made to the JIC standard, which means the hex nuts on some sizes are smaller than what is required to totally cover an O-ring when you try to turn a JIC male hose tail into a UNO male hose tail.

What are the alternatives?

1. We do have a few sizes in UNO male hose tails.
2. We could redesign the JIC males to have a larger hex but have a think about what that is going to do for the other applications. For example, confined spaces or where a tube with flare nut requires a male, or it's on a multi-port valve bank.

The design provides a quick and easy solution for bundling hose groups together and should turn a mammoth task into a simple solution. It can also be used for many other applications.

Sleeve can be cut using standard scissors. A heat gun is useful for sealing the cut edge. The part number is: *Fastwrap* plus the size: e.g. *Fastwrap-25*. Each size comes in 25m rolls.

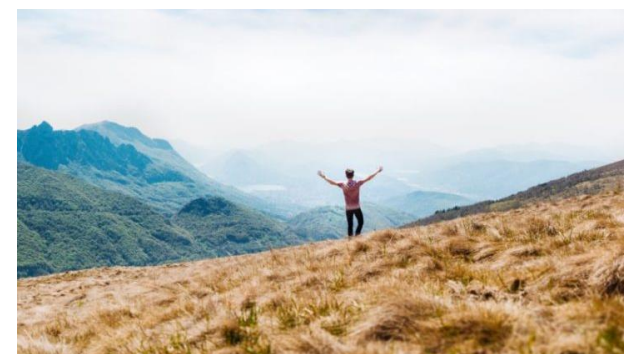
1. **Choose the Correct Path.**
